
At ExCeL London we take every event to heart. From our people to our space, we know what it takes to stay ahead, which is why sustainability and CSR are such important aspects of our strategy and day-to-day activity.



We are certified to both the ISO14001 environmental standard and the ISO20121, which sets sustainability management standards in the event industry. We currently focus on three key areas: reducing waste, increasing energy efficiency, and ensuring our clients participate in ExCeL's sustainability objectives. We need the help of our organisers, visitors and contractors to help keep our venue green.



People are our greatest asset; they are the heart and lungs of our business. We benchmark in the top 10% of companies for our benefits package and ExCeL supports over 33,000 jobs — directly and indirectly — in the area. We believe this is the reason 38% of our staff have been with us for over ten years.



Our goal is zero waste to landfill. To achieve this, we have designated bins for plastic, cans, paper, cardboard and glass, and our Event Managers are on hand if events have specific recycling requirements. Any waste disposed of in general waste bins is turned into refuse-derive fuels. All of our food waste is diverted to our on-site wormery which contains over 300,000 worms and produces a soil additive which we use for landscaping.



In 2014 we upgraded our lighting system to energy saving LEDs which benefits over 3.6 million visitors, 110 exhibitions and 250 conferences.

To save energy lighting is set to 50% during build-up and break-down of shows and increased to 100% during open days – though this can be reduced at the organiser's discretion.



We are committed to operating as a responsible corporate entity.

That's why we fund two major projects in the local community: Newham All Star Sports Academy (NASSA) and Community Food Enterprise (CFE). We also provide complimentary event spaces to selected schools and charities, run venue tours, and host a week long 'ExCeL In The Arts' campaign for Newham children.
